Explanation of Responses:

- Includes 91,527 shares acquired under the Biogen Inc. Employee Stock Purchase Plan on 3/31/2017.
- The restricted stock units will vest in 2 annual installments. One-third will vest on the first anniversary of the grant date and two-thirds will vest on the second anniversary of the grant date.
- The number of RSUs reported represents the maximum possible number of shares that are eligible for vesting, which is 200% of the number of shares at target payout. One-third of these RSUs are eligible to vest on each of the first three anniversaries of the grant date. The actual number of shares that will vest on each vesting date will be determined by comparing the price of Biogen common stock on such vesting date to the price on the grant date (i.e., number of vested shares = number of shares at target payout times [the 30-day average closing stock price ending on the vesting date divided by the 30-day average closing stock price following and including the grant date]).
- The number of RSUs reported represents the maximum possible number of shares that are eligible for vesting, which is 200% of the number of shares at target payout. One-fourth of these RSUs are eligible to vest each year for four years, beginning two years from the date of grant. The actual number of shares that will vest on each vesting date will be determined by comparing the price of Biogen Idcc common stock on such vesting date to the price on the grant date (i.e., number of vested shares = number of shares at target payout times [the 30-day average closing stock price ending on the vesting date divided by the 30-day average closing stock price on the grant date]).
